Bob Good, executive director, is competing for the Maddox Prize and as part of its competition it asks who have you engaged to advance science and what hostility have you faced. What needs to be done and how do you fund it? Its all laid out in the letters on the web site, including this one to you.

Setting up the specifics, the organization allows for the funneling of funds into areas that need science done unimpeded by politics or any other interest group that can be named.

In terms of my competition for the Maddox prize you have been engaged. I sincerely hope you respond to the positive, and explanation for the research can be found in the book I have submitted for the Maddox Competition the Mathematics of the Science of Reincarnation and the business proposal itself is covered in chapters 15-17. My co-authors on the proposal are Dean Radin and Stephan A. Schwartz.
